Thought for the day

'Salt for others, light for others'

Because salt does not give flavour to itself but serves others.

Light does not illuminate itself but serves others.
Supermarkets sell salt in small quantities, not by the ton. And
salt does not promote itself because it doesn't serve itself. It
exists to serve others, by conserving things and giving flavour.

This is simple witness. Daily Christian witness means being
light for others, 'to help them in their darkest hour'. 'The Lord
says: 'You are salt; you are light. 'But do so in order that others
see and glorify God. You will not even receive any merit. When
we eat, we don't compliment the salt, no, we say the pasta is
good, the meat is good. When we go to sleep at night, we
don't say the light is good, we ignore the light, but we live
illuminated by light. This impels Christians to be anonymous
witnesses. Do not act like the Pharisee who thanks the Lord
for his holiness. We are not the authors of our own merits.
Everyday holiness means being salt and light for others.
